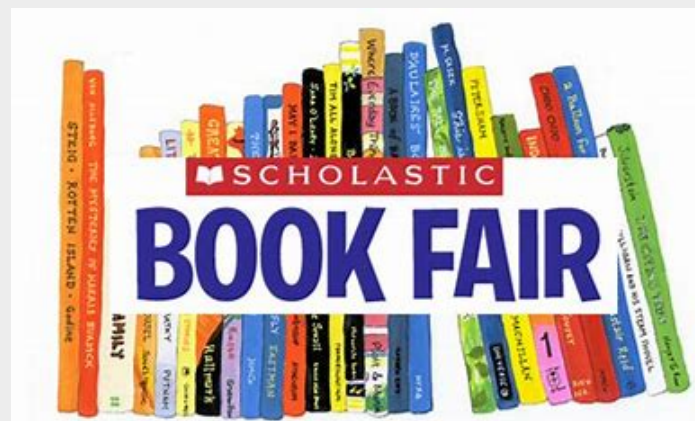
Parent/Teacher consultations: Monday 26th - Wednesday 28th February. Appointments times have been given to all pupils.

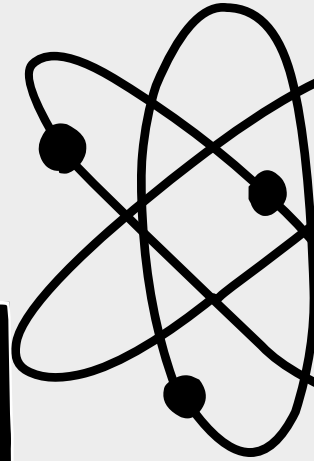
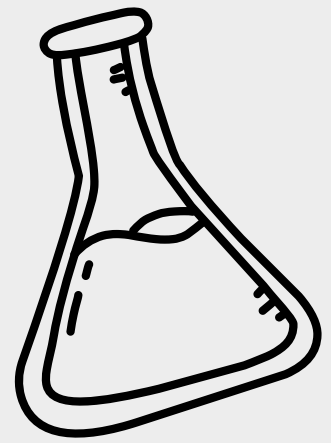

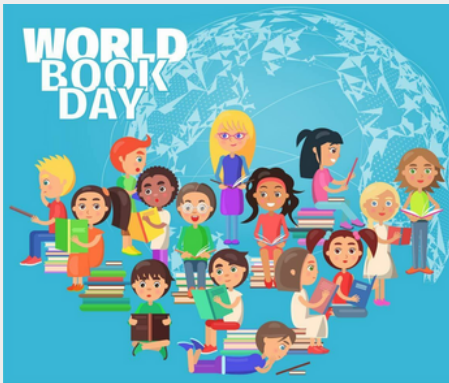
