## KEY WORKER - ARRIVAL AND COLLECTION

Bubble 1: Children are to enter the premises via the playground gate and come to the door of Class 1 (top yard). A parent/carer can escort their child to the door and collect from there at the end of the school day.

Bubble 2: Children are to enter the premises via the playground gate and come to the door of Class 4 (bottom yard). A parent/carer can escort their child to the door and collect from there at the end of the school day.

## WHEN TO SELF-ISOLATE

Self-isolate immediately if:

- You have any [symptoms of coronavirus](#) (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- You've tested positive for coronavirus- this means you have coronavirus
- You live with someone who has symptoms or tested positive
- Someone in your support bubble has symptoms or tested positive
- You're told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace or the NHS COVID-19 app
- You arrive in the UK from a country with a high coronavirus risk- see [www.gov.co.uk](http://www.gov.co.uk)
- Under Government guidelines, the isolation period is now 10 days.
