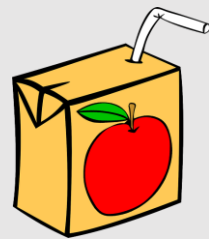
RECEPTION CHILDREN

The children will be walking to the Quarry Tea House and will experience ordering their drinks and a little treat!

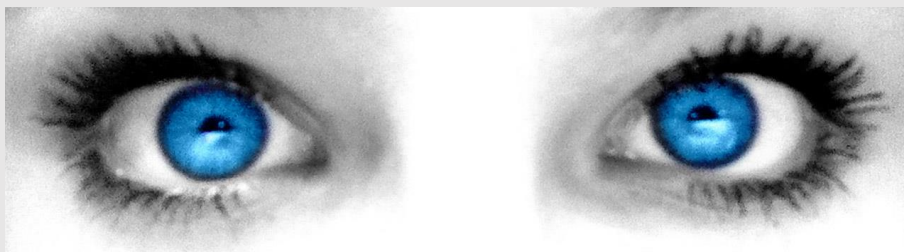
A contribution of £1 to support this experience would be very much appreciated. Please could this be sent into school in a named envelope.

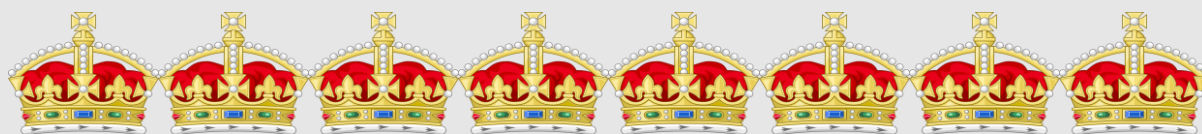


THE QUEEN'S JUBILEE 2022

HELP STOP THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS

- get vaccinated against COVID-19 – everyone aged 12 and over can [book vaccination appointments](#) now
- meet people outside if possible
- open doors and windows to let in fresh air if meeting people inside
- limit the number of people you meet and avoid crowded places
- wear a face covering in shops, on public transport and when it's hard to stay away from other people (particularly indoors or in crowded places)
- wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitiser regularly throughout the day

WHEN TO SELF-ISOLATE

Self-isolate immediately if:

- You have any [symptoms of coronavirus](#)
- You've tested positive for coronavirus.
- People who are fully vaccinated, or children and young people aged between 5 and 18 years and 6 months, identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19, should take an LFD test every day for seven days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result or develop symptoms at any time.

From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be [reported to NHS Test and Trace](#).
