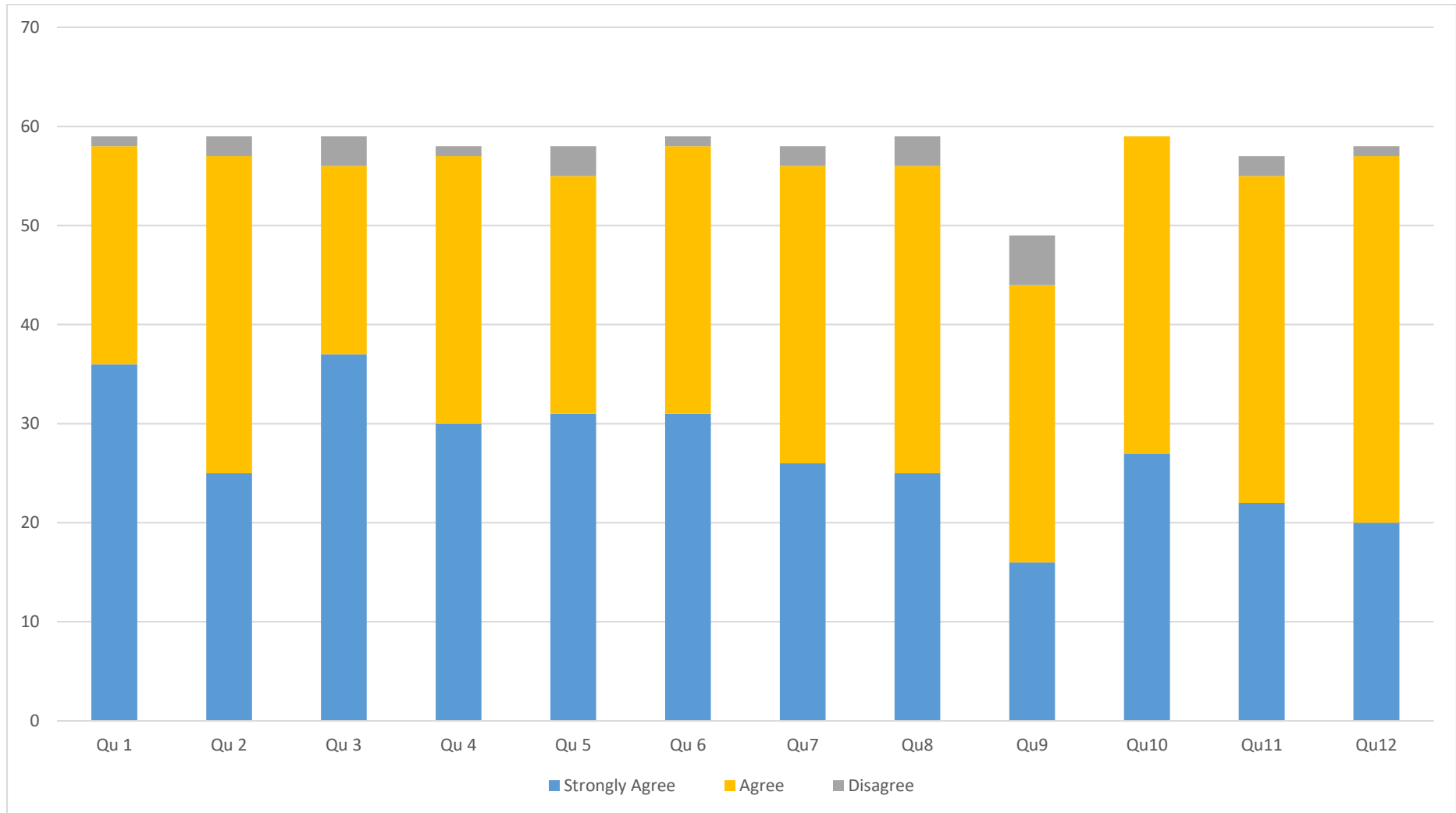
Key Information:

59 questionnaires were received and analysed.

Question Outcomes:

1	My child feels safe at this school.
2	My child is making good progress.
3	My child is happy at Hunwick Primary School.
4	This school ensures my child is well looked after.
5	My child is taught well at this school.
6	This school helps my child to develop skills in communication, reading, writing and mathematics.
7	The school makes sure children are well behaved in school.
8	Hunwick Primary School is well led and managed.
9	This school deals with any cases of bullying effectively. (Bullying includes persistent name-calling, cyber, racist and homophobic bullying).
10	The school helps me support my child's learning.
11	This school responds well to my concerns.
12	This school keeps me well informed.

Analysis of the responses:

- 37/59 responses STRONGLY AGREED that their child was happy at Hunwick Primary School (Qu 3). This is a fantastic percentage which reflects the happy nature of the school.
- 36/59 responses STRONGLY AGREED that their child felt safe at school (Qu 1). This percentage will hopefully rise in response to the feedback obtained during this questionnaire and some parents have suggested the metal fencing could run the whole length of the lower playground. The senior leadership team are currently consulting with local businesses to see if this option is feasible.
- 49 responses were received for question 9 – many questionnaires had comments on to say the parent/carer had not had any experience of bullying at Hunwick Primary School therefore could not make an informed choice. As a school we feel this is a positive situation as it demonstrates that the teaching of the PSHCE curriculum, British Values and the general ethos of the school is highlighting that bullying in any form is not tolerated.
- **The strengths of the school in 2015-16 were:**
 - Safe and happy children: ensuring my children are well looked after.
 - The teaching at Hunwick Primary School: helping children develop skills in communication, reading, writing and mathematics.

Individual responses:

'I appreciate my child's class teacher informing me when my child is struggling at a particular subject/topic and sending examples home to enable me to give her additional support.'

'You are approachable – I can come and voice my concerns if I have any.'

'The school provides a good range of afterschool activities.'

'You have supported and encouraged my child to be a happy, confident and valued person.'

'Fantastic teaching and support staff.'

'The standard of learning is brilliant.'

'The sports opportunities, the class newsletters informing us what the children will be learning each term, social and fun events such as film nights and trips and the after school clubs are excellent.'

'It is a very tight knit school and staff are very friendly and helpful.'

'I appreciate the way children are recognised and rewarded for their hard work and behaviour.'

'Communication with me about any concerns or issues is prompt and effective.'
